It seemed only fitting that the 'Axis of Evil' should be a spinner in the middle of the board. Almost three painful years later, *War on Terror*, the boardgame is ready for production.

A quality boardgame for 2-6 players, everything has been brilliantly illustrated by award-winning illustrator and cartoonist, Tom Morgan-Jones. In the box there's money, oil counters, Axis of Evil spinner, secret message pads and even a free 'EVIL balaclava'. All you need to fight the war on terror from your home.

Whether you chose to fund or fight terrorism, *War on Terror*, the boardgame is unlike any game you've ever played. It turns you against everything you hold dear - your friends, your family and even your own morals. Several games have been attributed with splitting up relationships, forging relationships, inciting tantrums, tears and lots of shouting - being a global superpower is *not* a peaceful night in. Everyone, though, comes back for more.

Brainchild of Cambridge natives, Andrew Sheerin and Andy Tompkins, TerrorBull Games was founded on the principle of "playing with your mind" and is on a mission to create a new breed of satirical boardgame. With global warming and immigration earmarked for TBG treatment, TerrorBull Games are set to take the games market by storm, if not by surprise.
